STEWARDSHIP 2018

Dear FUMC Heath,

In the life of the church, All Saints Day seems to signal the turn to a busy season: We've moved past Halloween, we're getting ready for Thanksgiving, all while planning and preparing for the Christmas season with the Children's Musical, Choir Cantata, and Christmas Eve services.

But there is one more season that drops in the middle of all this: Stewardship.

Because of your generous giving, we are in a blessed time and place in the history of our church: We have no debt on our building, our only debt is about \$38K remaining on the parsonage, we have cash in the bank equal to two-plus months of our operating expenses, and our Mother's Day Out program - Lil' Voyagers - is self-funding.

As we enter our budget season, we will use a combination of this year's stewardship commitments & our past trends to determine our future plans. Our hope is that we can dream bigger and increase our budget this coming year because of some needs and wants, including:

Needs:

\$5K Insurance Deductibles

\$10K New AC units/thermostats

\$5-\$7K Landscaping/Drainage

Finish paying for windows/flat roof repair

Wants

Increase our Outreach footprint

Increase Children's/Youth Ministry to full-time

Raises for our current staff (none the last 2 years)

However, Stewardship is more than a money conversation. To be sure, how we spend our money is a spiritual issue. But Stewardship at it's deepest level is how we tend to what God has most entrusted to each of us: The Good News of Jesus Christ.

We each are called to be stewards of the gospel, and we do so in how we steward our prayers, our presence, our gifts, our service, and our witness through our church and into our world. Each of these areas is based on a relationship with Jesus, our church, and others... and the ultimate goal of Stewardship is to bring people to Jesus!

The church needs your generous financial giving, but it also needs your prayers, your talents, and your time. Together are the church's greatest resource as we work to share the love of Jesus in our community and the world. During this season, we ask you to prayerfully consider each of these in your Stewardship commitment to FUMC Heath.

Then on Sunday, November 12, we ask you to bring the enclosed Stewardship Commitment card to our temporary "altar" during worship. If you are not able to be there, you can bring it another Sunday and place it in the offering plate, or mail it to the church office.

As we move through this season into celebrating all that God has given us through the birth of his Son, we thank you for all you have given to the church in 2017, and thank you in advance for all you will give in 2018 as we share the Good News of Jesus Christ!

MUSIC MINISTRIES

Being in music ministry for over 13 years I've heard:

"Why do we sing	song(s)?!" or
"Why can't we sing	song(s)?" or
"Why are we not singing	y song(s)?" or
"We haven't sung	song(s)!"

So, I thought I would share with you, the thought process on selecting hymns (both traditional and praise) for worship.

- 1. Read Bible for upcoming Sundays scripture, theme, message
- 2. Pray
- 3. Narrow down the songs with these things in mind: scripture, theology, tunes, inclusive language, familiarity and sing-ability
- 4. Pray
- 5. Refine the song list down to reflect theology through prayer, meditation and the Holy Spirit
- 6. Pray
- 7. Criteria: Can this song be used by God to transform people's lives?
- 8. Pray
- 9. Criteria: Will this song invoke questions, challenges and strengthen to our belief/faith in God?
- 10. Pray
- 11. After narrowing down to 3-5 songs; Practice! Over and over again till I get the pronunciation right, feels right in the voice and in my hands.
- 12. Prav
- 13. Finalize the selections
- 14. Pray
- 15. Practice! To emphasize the key words and phrases to reflect scripture and theology.
- 16. Pray
