The mystery of our faith is also the hope of our lives: **Christ has died. Christ is risen. Christ will come again.** We get that Jesus was born, crucified, and is risen... but we often loose sight that he's also enthroned in heaven, interceding for the world, and will one day return to make all things new again. This is the final stage of the new mission God began after humanity fell.

Advent means *the arrival of a notable person, thing, or event.* For Christians, it's when we celebrate the arrival of Jesus Christ. But before we celebrate Jesus's silent-night first arrival in the manger, we prepare for his trumpet-blasting second coming in the clouds.

Advent gives us the opportunity to pause and take inventory... to start with the end in mind and see if our lives look like our beliefs and prayers... so that Jesus's Kingdom can come on Earth as it is in Heaven. This season, Pastor Omar will host a three - week Advent study on Wednesday mornings at 9am or Wednesday evenings at 6pm on **December 6th, 13th, and 20th**.



Confirmation is an important marker in the spiritual journey of our children. It is the opportunity to


"confirm" their faith, make their first public declaration of faith before their church family, and be received into full membership.
